Greetings from Uganda! I hope that you and your families had a blessed Christmas. As I mentioned in my last newsletter, the children had a wonderful Christmas here at The Home of the Holy Angels. While they don't have much in the way of possessions, they are very thankful for the life you've helped to create for them at our Home. As we move into 2017, I am very excited about a major project that you are making possible for our children. We have reached the point where we will soon begin construction on our Convent! This has been an important initiative over the past couple years, and I greatly

appreciate the support that so many of you have provided.



Some of the first steps we will be taking on our campus are to grade the land on which the Convent will be located, and to begin accumulating the building materials. I plan to have this underway before my annual trip to the United States which should begin in April or May. Once I return to Uganda after the end of the summer, we will formally begin the construction process and hope to be completed by

the end of 2017.



I am currently talking with the Mothers Superior for several orders of African nuns about having several Sisters join our mission once the Convent is completed. The Sisters will be a tremendous addition to our ministry and will help to restore even more the sense of family for these children who have lost so much. I hope that you are as excited as I am about this dream that will soon become a reality! I can't thank you enough for the sacrifices you have made to make this happen for our children. As construction begins and decisions are made on which order of nuns will join us, I will update you regularly. I will also include lots of pictures!
