Overall, our students finished THIRD in the entire Kibale district which is comprised of over four hundred schools!

We will continue our mentorship for graduating students! As our P7 students move from The Home of the Holy Angels to a local secondary school, we will continue to provide them with support, direction and mentoring.



Through your help, we have significantly changed the trajectory of their lives and want this to continue as they move from our campus to their new secondary school.

The cost of supporting our children at The Home of the Holy Angels is approximately \$600 per year.

We are so thankful to all of you who are currently supporting a child at this level through our Sponsor-a-Child Program.
